- Teams
 - A record high number of 62 teams have registered for the event, and as every year, there will be some late research projects registering
 - 62 student projects, 5 other projects
- Schedule 6.3.2014
 - 9.00-10.00 Stand set up
 - Stands will be set up by the teams.
 - Stand info: Poster wall (size 88 x 120 cm) and table (size 140x60 cm)
 - Electricity will be available, but bring your own extension cords to be on the safe side
 - Data connections through Spark-net / Eduroam, any more advanced data-connections you must negotiate with the technical people in your organization
 - The teams will be placed according to a map provided by the organizers (will be provided Thursday morning)
 - **10.00-14.00 ICT Showroom 2014 is open for the public**
 - 10.30-13.30 The jury evaluating the student projects will visit the stands!
 - The jury is not (yet) finalized, but consist of company representatives from the region
 - 10.00-14.00 The public can vote for the best
 - Presentation
 - Technical content
 - 14.30 Winners will be announced in auditorium Alpha
 - Student competition
 - Public voting
 - 14.00-14.30 Dismantling – **note – the teams must return any equipment to original location!**
- Posters and abstracts
 - Student posters will be printed by the organizers
 - Posters and abstracts must be submitted **before March, 3, 2014 12.00!**
 - Posters are submitted electronically at the www.it.abo.fi/ictshowroom
 - Using acquired URL at 1st registration (will also be received in a separate reminder email)
 - Make sure that the abstract also is up to date. The abstract will be used in a printer ICT Showroom program leaflet.
 - PDF format size A0, 4 colors. CHECK YOUR PDF FILE FORMAT IN AT LEAST 2 DIFFERENT COMPUTERS (no crazy fonts thank you...), file size maximum 10 MB
 - Student posters will be produced free of charge by the organizers. The organizers will keep the physical copy of the poster.
 - The posters will be available **Thursday morning (6.3.2014)**
 - **Research projects** shall produce their own posters, at own expense.
