- Teams
  - 31 student teams have registered for the event, and as every year, there will be some late research projects registering
    - 31 student projects, 10 research projects
    - Additionally, teams from Founder Institute/startup accelerator will take part in the exhibition
- Schedule 7.3.2013
  - 10.00-11.00 Stand set up
    - Stands will be set up by the teams themselves.
      - Stand info: Poster wall (size 88 x 120 cm) and table (size 140x60 cm)
      - Electricity will be available, but bring your own extension cords to be on the safe side
      - Data connections through Eduroam/SparkNet; any more advanced data-connections you must negotiate with the technical people in your organization before the event
    - The teams will be placed according to a map provided by the organizers at Thursday morning
  - **11.00-14.00 ICT Showroom 2013 is open for the public**
    - 11.30-13.30 The jury evaluating the student projects will visit the stands!
    - The jury consist of company representatives from the region
    - 11.00-14.00 The public can vote for the best

  - 14.30 Winners will be announced in auditorium Alpha
    - Student competition
    - Public voting
  - 14.00-14.30 Dismantling – **note – the teams must return any equipment to original location!**

    - Upload using the URL given in registration confirmation (also a reminder email will be sent)
    - PDF format: Size A0, 4 colors. CHECK YOUR PDF FILE FORMAT IN AT LEAST 2 DIFFERENT COMPUTERS (no crazy fonts thank you...), file size maximum 10 MB
    - Student posters will be produced free of charge by the organizers. The organizers will keep the physical copy of the poster after the event.
    - The posters will be available **Thursday morning (7.3.2013)**
    - Research projects shall produce their own posters, at own expense.
